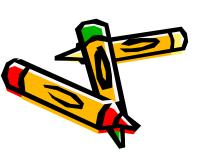





What is the Early Years Foundation Stage?


The Early Years Foundation Stage (E.Y.F.S.) is the stage of education for children from birth to the end of the Reception year.


It is based on the recognition that children learn best through play and active learning.



The EYFS Curriculum








- Your child will start school on <u>Tuesday 5th</u>

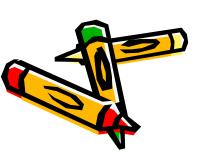




Your child will need a school reading bag for their reading book, library book and word cards.








Medical Matters

Asthma pumps must have your child's name on it. Pumps will be stored safely.








School dinners


Packed lunches need to be healthy. No chocolate or fizzy drinks please!






