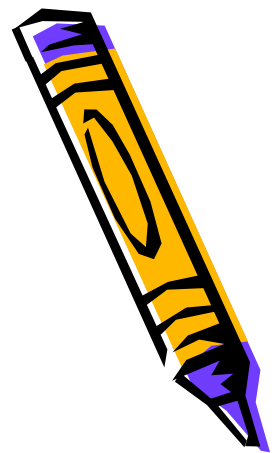

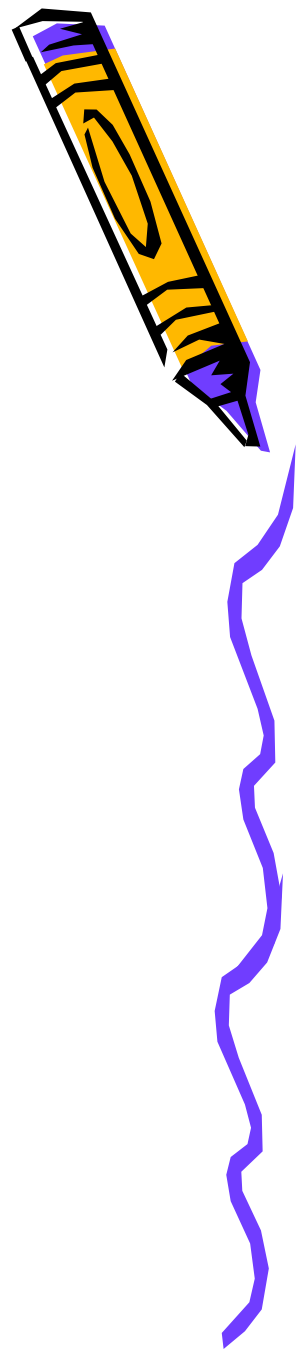


# OFSTED 2014

- Children feel very safe.



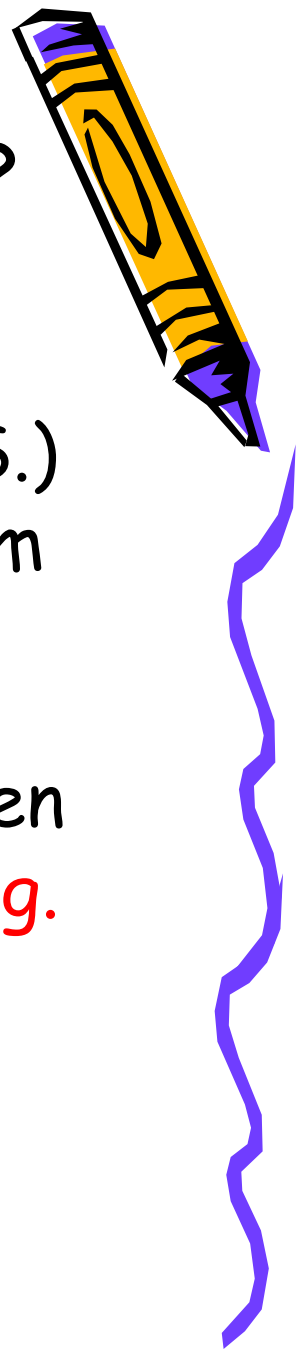

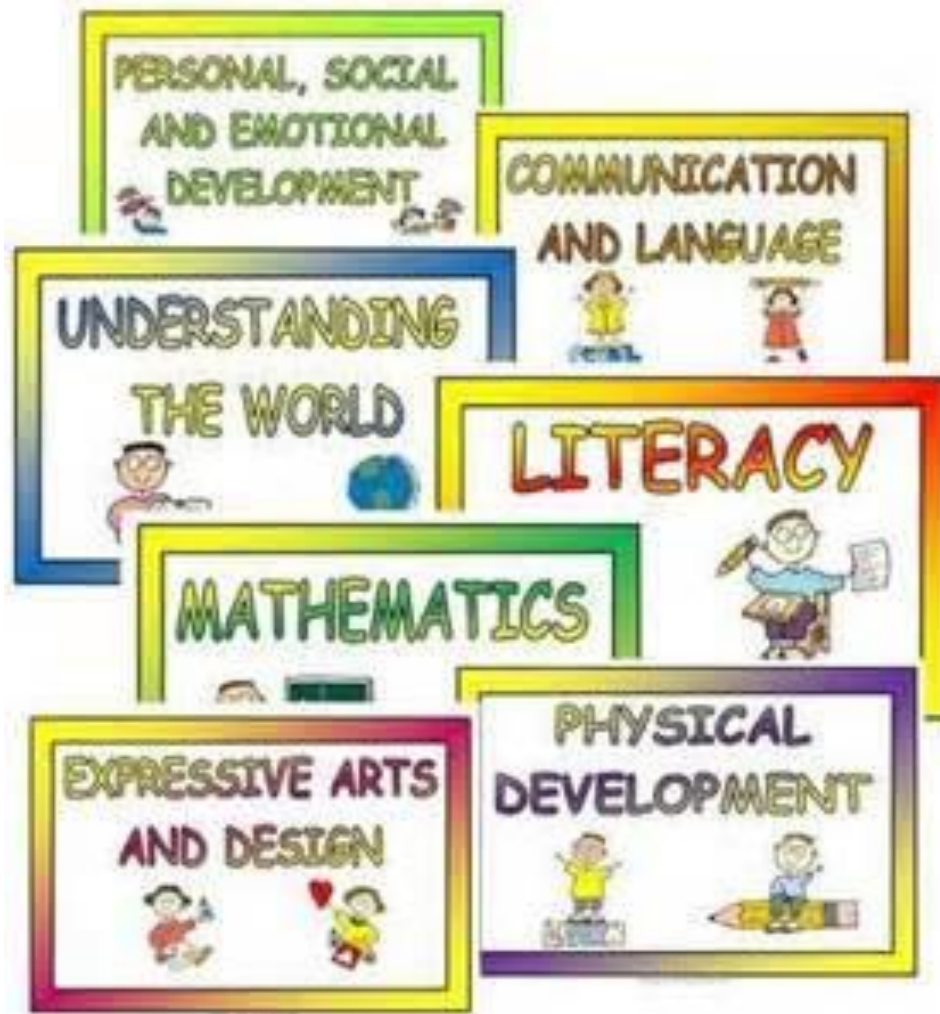
# What is the Early Years Foundation Stage?

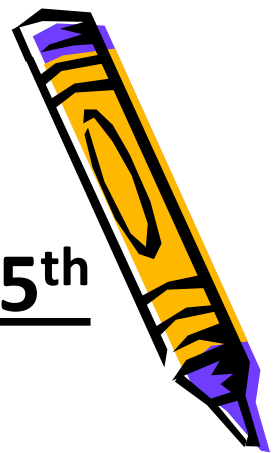
The Early Years Foundation Stage (E.Y.F.S.) is the stage of education for children from **birth** to the **end of the Reception year**.

It is based on the recognition that children learn best through **play and active learning**.



# The EYFS Curriculum



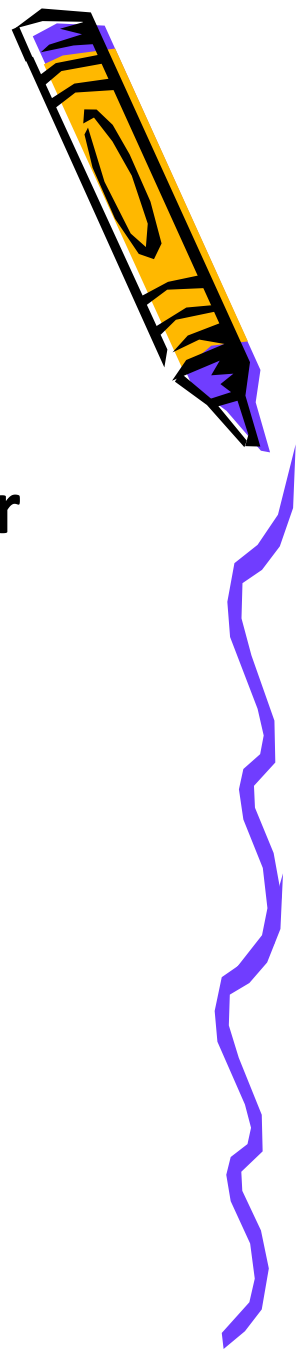


- Your child will start school on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September.**

- Week 2 – **Full time** ( 8.40am –3.05pm) beginning Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September



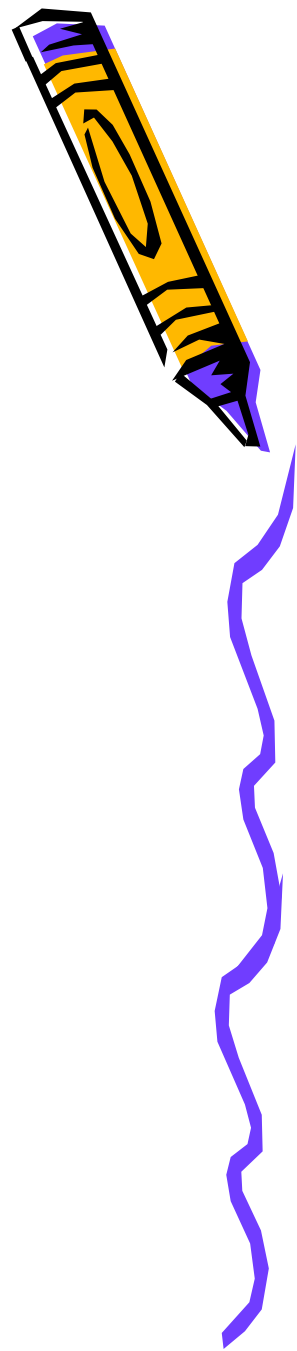

Am – 8:40am – 11:30am




We will inform you the name of your **child's class teacher** and whether they are required to attend **am or pm** for the first week by letter.

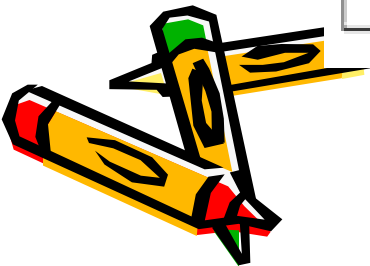
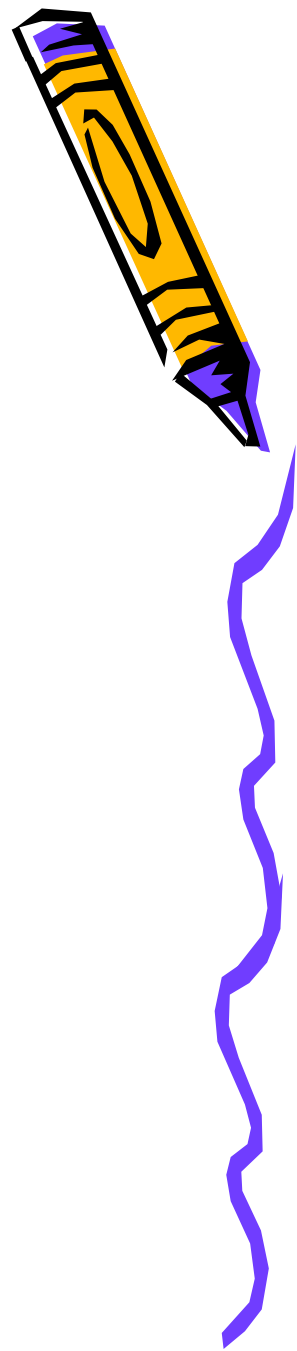


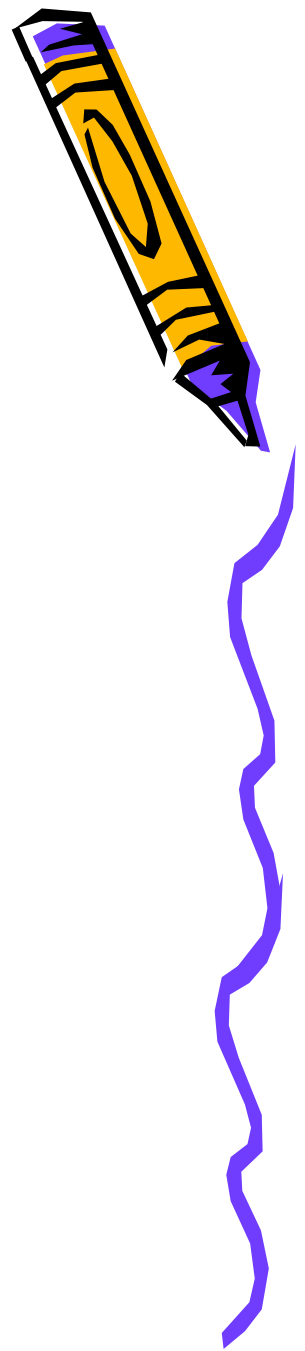

School finishes at 3:05pm.



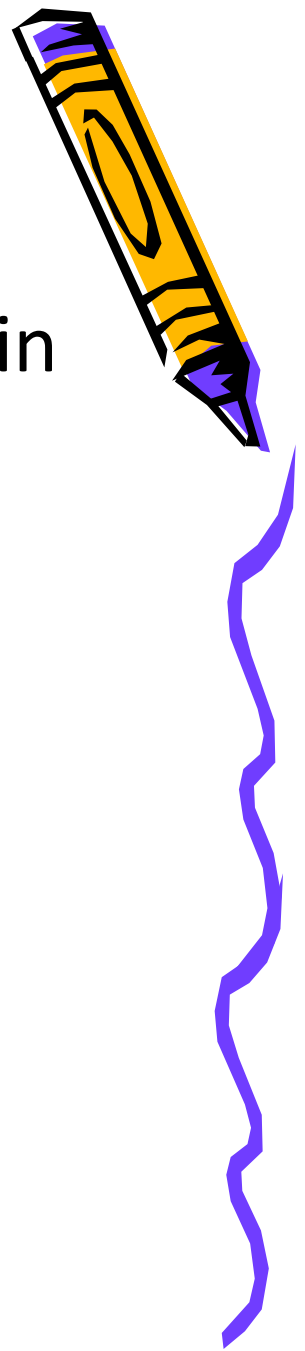

- Please ensure that your child's name is in all items of clothing, including shoes!



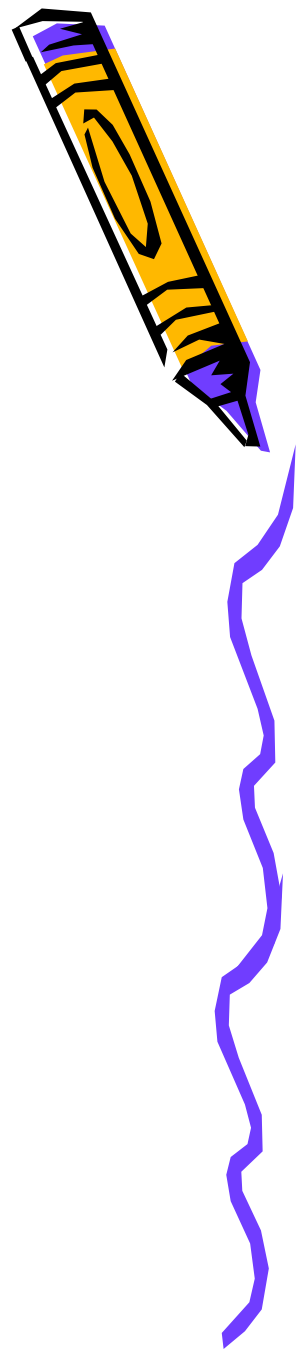
# School uniform shop

- We cannot give your child medicines.

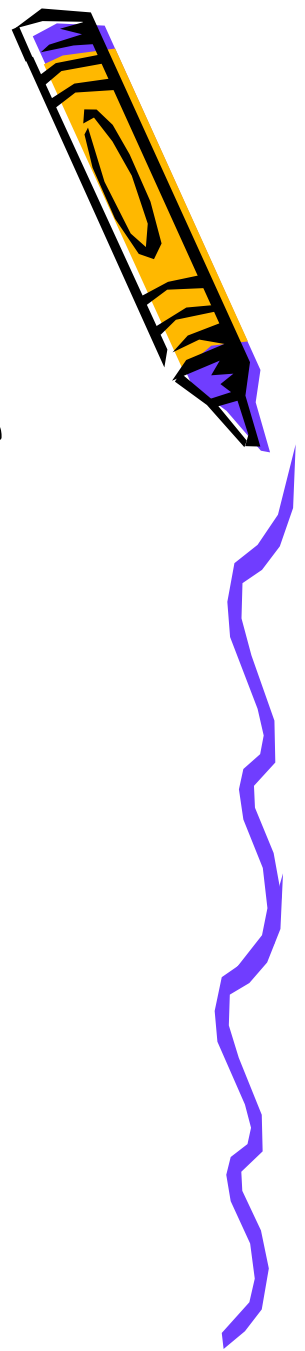
Asthma pumps must have your child's name on it. Pumps will be stored safely.

In the autumn term you will be invited to workshops or meetings for Literacy and Numeracy.

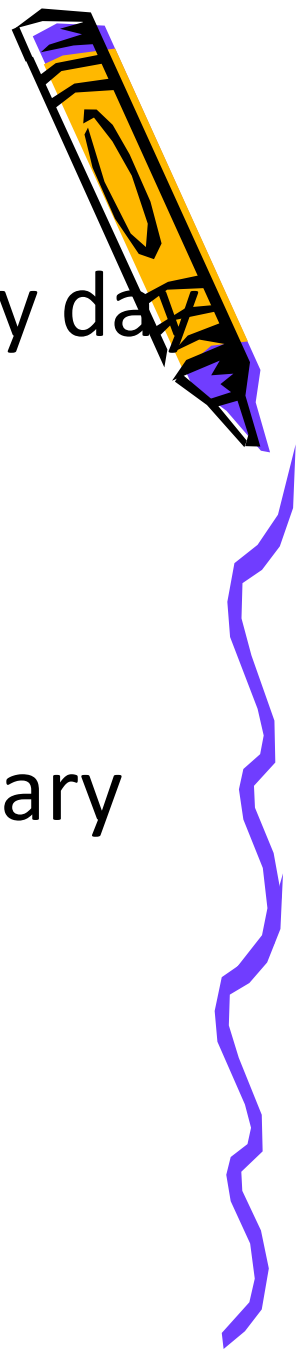

- Children with poor attendance do not perform as well as their peers at primary and secondary level.



# Pupil Premium

If you receive or have ever received and any of the following benefits:

- **Income Support**
